

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. General

The competition commences at 00:01 on the 22nd February 2010 and closes at 23:59 on 12th March 2010. Any entries received after the closing date will not be eligible for the competition.

2. Restrictions

This competition is open to youth projects who have received funding before 22nd February 2010 from the Department of Children Schools and Families via the Youth Opportunity Fund, the Youth Capital Fund, Youth Capital Fund+ or the Positive Activities for Young People initiative, in the following locations:

You must be aged 18 years or over to submit a video to enter this competition. Employees (and members of their immediate family) of "COI" and "DCSF" and anyone professionally connected to this competition are not eligible to enter.

3. How to enter

No purchase of any goods or services is necessary to be eligible for entry into this competition.

Upload your video entry to your own YouTube account and send the video link to yourtake@coi.gsi.gov.uk. The Central Office for Information (COI) will upload video entries onto the competition YouTube site: www.youtube.com/group/yourtakecompetition. COI may disqualify and refuse to upload any entries which in its opinion do not comply with these rules. COI will judge entries on behalf of the Department for Children Schools and Families for the 50 areas above. Seven regional panels will judge entries. Each panel will include an independent judge. The names of the judges are available on request.

The winning videos will have showcased their youth projects most effectively and creatively - showing real people, real locations and real issues from young peoples' perspectives.

You may enter multiple videos to the competition.

4. Prize

The prizes are pocket video cameras. There will be a camera available to win for each of the 50 eligible areas. There is no cash or other alternative prize available, except that in the event of circumstances outside of the promoter's control it reserves the right to substitute a similar alternative of equal or greater value. If there are no entries for an eligible area or if the

judges do not consider that any of the entries for an area are of a high enough quality to satisfy the winning criteria, no prize will be awarded for that area.

5. Results

The winner will be notified within 14 days of the close of the competition. In the event that the winner cannot be contacted (or prize acceptance, or proof of age or parental consent cannot be obtained) within those 14 days, the promoter reserves the right to withdraw prize entitlement and reallocate the prize. 6. Data Protection

In order to claim a prize participants must provide certain information on themselves. The promoter shall be considered the data controller for the database containing this personal information. The promoter has no control over or access to any personal data that participants may submit to YouTube and accepts no responsibility for any such personal data.

7. Conditions about your video

By entering this competition, you represent and warrant that:

- (a) you are the author of your video and any other information you submit to the promoter about the video and you own the copyright in each;
- (b) the video is your original work, is not copied, is not defamatory, obscene or blasphemous in any way and does not infringe any third party rights (including, without limitation, privacy);
- (c) the video has not been broadcast before in any media (except on YouTube);
- (d) you have obtained from anyone who appears in the video and any other contributors to the video (such as any writer and/or director) all necessary consents, releases, licences and waivers (including without limitation a waiver of the rights commonly known as "moral rights") to allow the promoter and YouTube to use the video as described in these terms and conditions. In particular, it is your responsibility to ensure that anyone who appears in the video is either over the age of 18 or has full consent from their parent or guardian to appear in the video;
- (e) you have also obtained all necessary rights from third parties (including consents (including without limitation from property owners), releases, licenses (including without limitation music licenses) and waivers) to allow the promoter and YouTube to use the video as described in these terms and conditions.

You must provide evidence to support these representations and warranties on our reasonable request. If we have reason to believe that your video does not satisfy these representations and warranties or is in breach of any applicable law or regulation or otherwise may create a liability for COI or DCSF, we may disqualify it from the competition and we reserve the right not to display your video. You shall be responsible for any losses, expenses or other costs incurred by the promoter resulting from any breach by you of these representations and warranties.

8. General Conditions

Any entry, which is damaged, of a rude nature, late or otherwise does not comply with these rules may be deemed invalid at the sole discretion of COI. COI also reserves the right to disqualify any entry which does not comply with YouTube's terms and conditions and/or which is removed from the YouTube site for any reason prior to the closing date of the competition. Use of false information will lead to disqualification. COI is not responsible for

technical, hardware or software malfunctions, misdirected entries, lost or unavailable network connections, or failed, incorrect, inaccurate, lost, late, illegible, misdirected, garbled, damaged or delayed electronic or other communications or other technical problems related to website entries. Proof of sending will not be deemed to be proof of delivery. COI cannot be held responsible for lost entries.
